Position Description:

The University of South Florida, School of Social Work invites applications for an Instructor, twelve-month non-tenure track position. This position will be dedicated to providing instruction and administrative support to the BSW and MSW programs in the school. We encourage applicants who are interested in joining our School of Social Work scholarly faculty in educating social work professionals and contributing to priority areas of teaching and service in social welfare policy and social work education. As part of the College of Behavioral and Community Sciences, members of our faculty engage in innovative behavioral interdisciplinary and translational research focused on finding solutions which lead to improvements in the quality of life, health and the safety of diverse populations. Social work faculty members contribute to the mission of the college by preparing professional social workers and leaders for social work practice committed to social justice and evidence based social work practice. The responsibilities of this position include: teaching undergraduate and graduate level courses and contributing to the service and administrative support needs in the school. Minimum Qualifications:

MSW from a CSWE accredited institution plus DSW or Ph.D. in Social Work or related field, two years of post-graduate social work practice experience, and at least five years of experience in teaching and instruction- related activities in social work education.

Preferred Qualifications:

Administrative experience in social work education and experience in curriculum development and evaluation consistent with CSWE accreditation standards. Experience in teaching social welfare policy and services and interest in and commitment to diversity.

The position begins summer, 2011.

The BSW and MSW programs are fully accredited by the Council on Social Work Education. The School of Social Work also offers a part-time Ph. D. program providing working professionals the opportunity to earn a research doctorate while continuing to work in social work practice. The School enjoys robust support from dedicated community leaders in addition to alumni, ensuring that students are provided with learning experiences that are educationally enriched, innovative, and diverse.



About the Application Process

Applications should include a cover letter detailing the applicant's qualifications for the position: a description of the applicant's teaching, administration and practice experiences in social work education; full contact information for at least three references; (approval to contact references is assumed unless otherwise stated) a current curriculum vita; a summary of student evaluation of instruction data and a succinct statement about teaching philosophy.
