Welcome and Review:

1. Call to Order: **Chair** (Frisch unable to attend; all others present)
2. Approve minutes from last meeting on 11/16/16: motion to approve by MacKinnon-Lewis, seconded by Simmons; Approved.

New business:

1. Mental Health Law & Policy: MHS 4434 Behavioral Health and the Family - review for GCP (Kyaieen Conner): current course already includes GCP content; a few minor changes: update “Blackboard” to “Canvas”, and “Turn It In” to “Safe Assignment”. Motion to approve with changes by Simmons, seconded by Rigg; Approved.
2. Mental Health Law & Policy: MHS 4425 Field Experience review for capstone recertification (Amy Gierhahn) - recertifying course for Gen Ed before new changes take effect; added ethical perspectives assignment; minor changes to objectives and outcomes (refer to Bloom’s taxonomy), add how outcomes are measured. Motion to approve with changes by Mitchell, seconded by Simmons; Approved.
3. School of Social Work: SOW 4522 Multicultural America in a Global Society review for GCP (Chris Simmons) - current course already offers a multicultural perspective; gives social work students an opportunity to be GCP certified, added problem based learning project, added cultural immersion project. Motion to approve by MacKinnon-Lewis, seconded by Jorgensen-Smith; Approved.

4. CBCS PhD in Behavioral & Community Sciences: changes to GRE requirements (Catherine Batsche): first cohort didn't meet GRE requirements (too high), modifying GRE criteria based on Grad School recommendations; added detail to goal statement; may move up application deadlines; motion to approve with changes by MacKinnon-Lewis, seconded by Rigg; Approved.
