Old business:

- I. **Call to Order** by Ryan Henry; Boeringer present by phone; Dobbs not available; all other committee members present.
- II. **Review October, 2015 meeting minutes:** reviewed; motion to approve by Rigg; seconded by Frisch; approved with minor changes.

New business:

- I. **Minor in Aging Sciences** proposal changes (Stanback): rationale strong, minor text changes (change Studies to Sciences; change major to minor; delete second “required” in first sentence); motion to approve by MacKinnon; seconded by Frisch; approved with minor changes. Next meeting review required course for Global Citizen Project (GCP).
- II. New **Minor in Forensic Behavioral Health** proposal (Batsche, Thompson): no new courses; all but 1 are online; specify both online and face-to-face options in catalog; suggest an intro class for non-social & behavioral science majors; add as certificate later on; motion to approve by Simmons; seconded by Rigg; approved with minor changes.
- III. **PhD in Behavioral & Community Sciences** proposal (Batsche): needs FIU and FAMU approval; possible FAMU collaboration; use existing courses when possible; received concurrence from Psychology and College of Education; reviewed curriculum section (pages 35-41); pg. 39 change 30 hours to 18 hours; pg. 37 change “interim” to “academic” advisor; pg. 36 #2 - 3.5 GPA “or higher” for last 60 hours, #5 “and/or” commitment, #6 add “applicable towards 90 hours”, pg. 37 #2 add SACS teaching requirement; pg. 48 move Learned Societies to section G; motion to approve by Frisch; seconded by MacKinnon; approved with changes.

- IV. **PhD in BCS: 4 new course offerings** (Moore, Goldstein, Batsche):
 - a. MHS 7707: add Title IX standard language; add list of articles in lieu of textbooks
 - b. MHS 6491: revise course objectives, course description, learning outcomes; add Title IX language
 - c. MHS 7721: revise course objectives; revise abbreviated title; course repeatable; course credits max of 3
 - d. MHS 6741: revise abbreviated title
 - e. Approved together with PhD proposal above.
