The IAFPA fosters research and provides a forum for the interchange of ideas and information regarding practice, development and research in forensic phonetics and acoustics. The group also sets and enforces standards of professional conduct and procedures for those involved in forensic phonetic and acoustic casework.

What is involved in phonetic and acoustic casework? Members participate in a wide array of cases including speaker identification/elimination, speaker profiling, voice line-ups, transcription, authentication, signal enhancement, and sound propagation at crime scenes. In 2007, the IAFPA established standards and procedures applied to cases involving the analysis of language and speech in the determination of national identity

IAFPA members are routinely called upon by local, federal and international policing agencies to analyze evidence and testify in trials.
