Fall semester marks a number of new and exciting changes for the FMHI Research Library. Starting next week, FMHI Library staff will begin transitioning select resources to USF's Main Campus Library. This process marks many months of dedicated effort by FMHI, CBCS, Research Library and Main Library faculty and staff to identify, select and retain those items most closely aligned with the teaching and research needs of the Library's patrons.

How will these changes affect you?

- *Serial publications kick-off the first phase of materials being moved to the Main Library.*

If you're unable to locate your favorite journal, please ask Library staff to assist you. Journal articles are just a click away with the USF Libraries' available e-resources and Interlibrary Loan and PRONTO services. (If you're not familiar with PRONTO, check it out here: <http://www.lib.usf.edu/ill/pronto/>. PRONTO is a direct-to-you document delivery service that expedites USF faculty's receipt of on-campus Library materials.)

- *Traffic in and around the FMHI Research Library will increase.*

Although we do not anticipate an increase in noise, it is possible. Library staff will make every effort to maintain reasonable noise levels and accommodate those needing quiet study and meeting spaces.
